We have been serving as a pilot/mechanic family in Brazil since 2006 and for the past four years, serving in northwestern Brazil, helping to start a helicopter program. The Celtic cross reminds us, as Presbyterians, of our historical roots in the British Isles dating back at least to the fifth century. *Post Tenebras Lux* is a Latin slogan from the 16th-century Protestant Reformation meaning *After Darkness, Light*.
