### MYCHOICE PREGNANCY CENTER

*with Mission to the World in Japan*

After teaching in a Christian high school for 10 years Jane Brinkerhoff participated in Mission to the World's summer missions program in Asia. It was here that the Lord laid on her heart the great need for workers in His harvest field. She has used evangelistic Bible studies, small groups, and mercy ministries to help spread the gospel and start churches in unchurched towns in the greater Nagoya area of Japan, a country where Christians comprise less than one percent of the population.

"I praise God that the Prayer and Share men's group continues to function at 100% attendance", Jane states, "and that Nobuko, my neighbor, has started listening to our church sermons on-line again, discussing them with me when we walk. In a recent Art and Bible class, which began in Genesis and is now in the gospels, non-Christian, Kaori said, 'I keep seeing how the things predicted in the Old Testament are all coming true hundreds of years later in Jesus' life!... He is central to everything!' ".
