DR. JODY COLLINGE

Our Great Commission Focus this month is on Dr. Jody Collinge: a New Yorker and pediatrician who resides in and works from the resort city of Zihuatanejo on Mexico's Pacific Coast, northwest of Acapulco. Dr. Jody works with Global Community Health Evangelism Network, a ministry that serves in over 100 countries worldwide; and she develops training materials for Children's Community Health Evangelism, a member of the network.

Her day job takes her into squatter communities in the hills overlooking the City where Kids' Clubs have been established. In these Clubs, Bible Skills, English as a Second Language, and First Aid and Health skills are taught. Several church plants have emerged as a result of these Kid's Clubs. Her job also takes her to other countries to work with others who are similarly involved with Children's Ministries and to provide training. Please keep this remarkable servant of the Lord before Him in earnest prayer.
