## Missions Work Highlight

#### RICHARD AND ROBYN CRANE

Richard, born in Chile, completed his early education in the US. He received his ministerial education and training at Covenant College and Covenant Seminary, earning B.A. and M.Div. degrees, respectively. He also studied at Westminster Seminary and has Chilean Certification in Systems Family Therapy. Robyn is from Pennsylvania and earned her B.A. in Bible and teacher certification at Covenant College. She also studied at Covenant Seminary. From 1979 to 1991, the Cranes working with the National Presbyterian Church in Chile, helped to plant various churches and founded a Christian Counseling and Training Center (PEPP). From 1992 to 1999 they developed EMEP, a Chilean expression of Marriage Encounter that helps bring couples to Christ and into the Cristo Rey Church where Richard was a pastor until 2002. In 2003 the Cranes moved to Miami where Richard works with various organizations connected to MTW developing distance education courses in pastoral psychology. They reach Spanish speakers all over the globe, conducting leadership training by extension via the internet, printed material, and intensive courses overseas.

The Celtic cross reminds us, as Presbyterians, of our historical roots in the British Isles dating back at least to the fifth century. Post Tenebras Lux is a Latin slogan from the 16th-century Protestant Reformation meaning After Darkness, Light. The cross and the slogan combine to express our desire to be rooted in the ancient faith and to embrace the attainments of the Protestant Reformation.
